Time-Limited Dynamic Psychotherapy (TLDP) provides a state-of-the-art, **empirically-supported** model of treatment that incorporates current developments in **neuroscience, object- relations, attachment, emotionally-focused, and experiential** theories, as well as **cognitive-behavioral** and **systems** approaches. This introductory/intermediate workshop will give practical information to therapists who wish to “**make every session count**” with their clients. TLDP privileges accessing **deep emotion and experiential learning**.

Learning Objectives:

1. Select and assess patients appropriate for TLDP.
2. Construct a dynamic focus to keep the therapy attuned to specific goals.

5. Understand how to use TLDP with difficult patients.

Hanna Levenson, Ph.D. is the author of over **75 professional papers and three books** (*Time Limited Dynamic Psychotherapy: A Guide to Clinical Practice*, *Brief Dynamic and Interpersonal Therapy*, and *Brief Dynamic Therapy*). In her latest book (2010) Dr. Levenson integrates **emotionally-focused, experiential, and interpersonal** approaches. Dr. Levenson also has three professional videos illustrating her approach. Her most recent video (2009) is a six session therapy-over-time DVD for APA as part of their **Expert Therapist Series**.



She is a **Fellow of Division 29** (Psychotherapy) of the APA and **Professor** at the Wright Institute in Berkeley, California. She has taught at Stanford University and has given numerous workshops and presentations on time-limited dynamic therapy to various community mental health centers, private practice groups, hospitals, and universities nationally and internationally.
